



Drama Club Returns to the Stage

Drama Club's plan is to direct and produce Almost Maine which is a "vignette" style show that only has 3-6 actors on stage at any time and is FAR less costly than a musical.

There is a possibility of having students rehearse in small vocal groups (2-3 students) that would perform songs from shows.

Rehearsal will be in small numbers of 3-6 students at a time and will rehearse outside under the portico whenever weather allows.

Health & Safety Precautions:

1. Mrs. Cormier, RN and Drama Director will interview each student certifying there has been no illness or direct exposure to COVID 19 in the last 14 days.
2. Students and staff would wear masks at all times, unless a distance greater than 6 feet can be maintained and even then they would be strongly encouraged. Everyone will be provided a mask if they do not come with one on. Gloves will be available for anyone requesting it.
3. Each student and staff member's temperature would be taken upon arrival by Mrs. Cormier RN and every 3 hours after that. If a temperature greater than 100.0, the person will be immediately isolated and arrangements for pick up will be made. Parents, staff and health department, when appropriate will be notified of illness.
4. Students would use hand sanitizer upon arrival and everytime they exit the stage at a minimum. Hand sanitizer will be provided at all entrances of the auditorium and in each dressing room and back stage right and left. Students and staff will be strongly encouraged to wash their hands/use hand sanitizer every hour.
5. Students would apply their own makeup. For students who don't have their own, dollar store eyeliner and mascara would be provided.
6. If a student requires assistance with makeup, Mrs. Cormier RN will provide it. Gloves, mask and face shield will be worn and gloves changed between each student. As per proper protocol, hands will be washed or sanitized after each glove removal.
7. All stage directions will be altered such that there was no direct skin to skin contact.
8. After each exit from the stage, students would leave backstage, use hand sanitizer



9. Lighting techs would wear masks and maintain social distance as much as possible.
10. Sound techs would wear masks and gloves at all times due to proximity.
11. Stage crew would wear masks and gloves at all times and maintain 6 foot social distance whenever possible. A Maximum of 4 stage crew members per side.
12. There would be 6 foot markings placed in the hallway around the auditorium to allow students to await entrances to mitigate risk.
13. Microphones will be cleaned with alcohol wipes and stored individually for each student (the student uses the same microphone).
14. Janitorial staff will provide appropriate cleaning of auditorium, bathrooms, classrooms and hallways per protocol after each rehearsal and performance.
Rob Cormier tech director will be responsible to clean and disinfect lighting and sound equipment at the end of each rehearsal and performance.
15. Windows in the classrooms used would be open for increased ventilation.
