Enrichment Program Survey

The Onondaga Central School District has been developing and administering summer and after school programs funded by the American Rescue Plan Act since the summer of 2021. The Federal funding provided by this act is intended to boost American schools, allotting \$125 billion to K-12 school districts and state education departments. Most of the money is intended to address learning loss suffered by students during pandemic-induced school closures. Additionally, this money could be transformational in re-inventing schooling to ensure that students, especially those traditionally left behind, are provided with the teachers and tools they need to be successful. Within this presentation, you will view how the Onondaga Central School District plans to utilize the ARPA funding.

At OCS we have made use of the funds provided by this act to provide additional opportunities for students to engage in academic and social emotional pursuits both after school and during the summer. Some of the activities have included support in math, reading, and speech at level from elementary through high school. Students have also been able to reach outside of their comfort zones to try new things like bird watching, cheerleading, and acting. We are trying to collect some basic feedback from parents and caregivers about how successful these programs have been and how they might evolve to better support our students and our community.
