NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING OF THE VOTERS OF THE ONONDAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE ONONDAGA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that the Annual Meeting of the qualified voters of said School District will be held in the Rockwell Elementary Gymnasium Room and Junior/Senior High School Cafeteria in Nedrow, NY, on May 17, 2022 from 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M., for the purpose of voting upon the following propositions which shall be placed on the ballot in substantially the following form, with the proposed budget amount inserted after it has been approved by the Board of Education:

PROPOSITION I (Budget)

Shall the proposed budget of the Onondaga Central School District as recommended by the Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, be adopted and shall the Board of Education be authorized to levy the necessary taxes therefor?

PROPOSITION II

(Student Transport Vehicles)

Shall the Board of Education of the Onondaga Central School District be authorized to purchase and finance three replacement student transportation vehicles, including necessary furnishings, fixtures and equipment and all other costs incidental thereto, and expend a total sum not to exceed \$366,313, which is estimated to be the total maximum cost thereof, and said amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District, in the principal amount not to exceed \$366,313, shall be issued?

PROPOSITION III (Library)

Shall the Onondaga Central School District levy and collect a tax, pursuant to section 259 of the Education Law of the state of New York for the benefit of the Onondaga Free Library, in the sum of \$58,350 (an increase of \$1,700 from the levy of 2021-2022 which was the sum of \$56,650) for the continuing support and maintenance of the Free Library services offered to the district residents?

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN at such election, voters shall elect 3 members to the Board of Education, each for a 3 year term. Petitions for nominating candidates for office must be filed in the District Clerk's Office between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., no later than April 18, 2022. Each petition must be addressed to the District Clerk and be signed by at least 25 voters.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that qualified voters may obtain applications for absentee ballots from the office of the District Clerk. Completed applications for absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 P.M. on May 16, 2022, if the voter will personally appear at the District Clerk's Office to receive the ballot, must be received no later than 5:00 P.M. on May 10, 2022, if the absentee ballot is to be mailed to the voter.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a listing of all persons to whom an absentee or military ballot is issued will be available for inspection by any qualified voter during regular business hours in the Office of the District Clerk during the 5 days before the election, except Sunday, and on the election day, and will be posted at the polling place on May 17, 2022.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that military voters who are qualified voters of the School District may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk at 315-552-5001, or jcirulli@onondagacsd.org. For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 P.M. on April 21, 2022. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or email.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN the budget hearing will be held on May 3, 2022 at 6 P.M., at in the Jr./Sr. High School Cafeteria at 4479 South Onondaga, Nedrow NY for the purpose of discussing expenditure of funds for the 2022-2023 school year and the budgeting thereof.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN residents may obtain a copy of the detailed statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes at each schoolhouse in the District in which school is maintained from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm on each day other than a Saturday, Sunday or holiday during the 14 days immediately preceding the election.
